

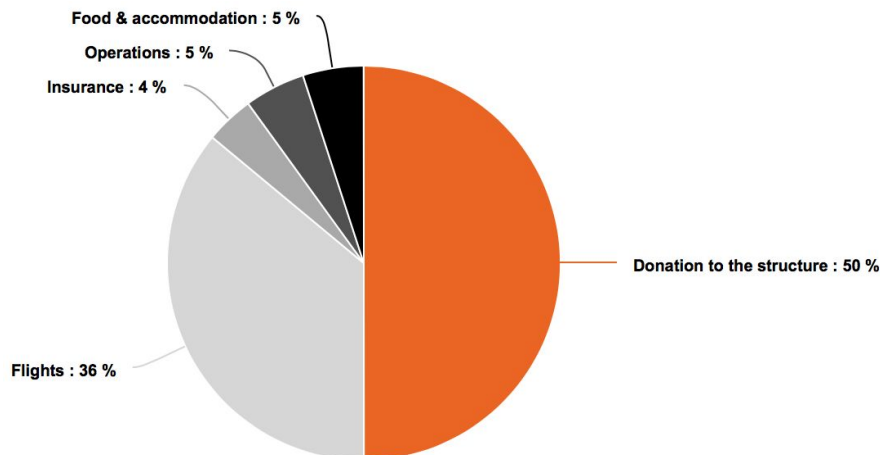


VOLUNTEERING WITH US

Purpose Projects is committed to changing lives. Not only the lives of the thousands of people and communities we impact every year, but also the lives of every single volunteer who comes abroad with us. Below is further information about our current volunteer projects, have a read through and, if you are interested in joining us, fill out our online application form.

Our volunteer trips are a little bit different to standard volunteering. If you volunteer with us, you will be part of a group of up to 30 people, fundraising and building a structure for an international community. Structures such as orphanages, schools and medical centers will provide access to shelter, education and health care for thousands of people in Uganda, East Africa. Our partner organisation Hope Line manages these structures. The trips that go over this year will be our first large-scale volunteer trips. We appreciate your support from the get-go, but we do want to give you a heads-up that the first few groups under our model will be helping us to fine-tune it in places.

Program costs for a trip are set at \$5,000 per person. Below is the price breakdown of this:



Donation to the structure: \$2,500 of the program cost goes directly towards paying for the new structure. A total of \$75,000 will be raised from these donations and will completely cover the construction costs to build a new school in Kkboa. You'll have to raise this money yourself but we're here to help you find work in your local community.

Flights: we are still working on confirming our partnership with an airline, but we arrange your return flights. You and the group will fly out of Auckland to Entebbe, Uganda and back together. It is still possible to travel before or after our trips, just note this in your application and we will work it out with you.

Insurance: we take care of sorting you high quality travel insurance that best suits the nature of our trips.

Operations: this covers coordination of placements, program research and development, pre-departure support and ongoing in-country support.



Food & accommodation: you will stay in our local guesthouse with the group and meals will be provided.

Excluded costs: immunisations, visas, extra travel or tourism costs and spending money.

Trip Payment includes a 5% non-refundable deposit of **\$250** to be paid by ~~the 1st June~~ **within a week of acceptance.**

Our plan is to take a group over **mid-January, 2019** for one month. If there is enough interest we will also take a group over in **late-November, 2018**. The group of 30 will work day-to-day in smaller groups of 6-8 people with each group having a group leader to help facilitate. You and the whole group will work alongside local tradespeople building a structure. No experience is needed, just a hard work ethic and a willingness to give it your best shot. In your smaller groups you will also be volunteering for Hope Line's local community development programs. This includes teaching, providing health care and farming. We tailor this service to certain areas of where you want to be or where you have experience.

Over the weekends there will be free time to explore the beautiful country with the whole group. There will also be an extra opportunity to travel to another country or to go on a safari. We have another partner organisation with an orphanage in Tanzania where you can visit, travel and volunteer as well.
